THE RETURN OF MEMORY

21 Oct 2017 – 7 Jan 2018

Featuring vinyl records, x-rays, murals, sculptures, a seed growing experiment and a staircase flipped on its side, this exhibition communicates a range of stories interpreted by artists of today who each respond in their own style to the current state of the 'New East' (Eastern Europe, The Balkans, Russia and Central Asia).



NOOR AFSHAN MIRZA & BRAD BUTLER: THE SCAR

In Turkey 1996, there was a fatal car crash. The four car passengers were: a former beauty queen, the deputy chief of the Istanbul Police Department, the leader of the terrorist group the Grey Wolves (also a contract killer on Interpol's red list) and a high ranking Parliamentary MP (the only survivor). Since then, three public investigations into the evidence, conspiracy theories and people implicated have linked the police, the government and the CIA to terrorism and the vast European heroin trade.

Noor Afshan Mirza and Brad Butler's work includes filmmaking, installation, drawing, publishing and curating. The artists draw influence from critical moments of change, protest and debate. The central piece to this exhibition is a film.
