## BITTER TEARS: THE FILMS OF RAINER WERNER FASSBINDER

One of the leading figures in the New German Cinema movement that emerged in the 1970s, Fassbinder, who worked in both cinema and theatre, was a furiously prolific artist and provocateur. Between 1969 and 1982 Fassbinder directed over 40 productions, so this short season hopefully provides a telling glimpse into the work of an uncompromising iconoclast.

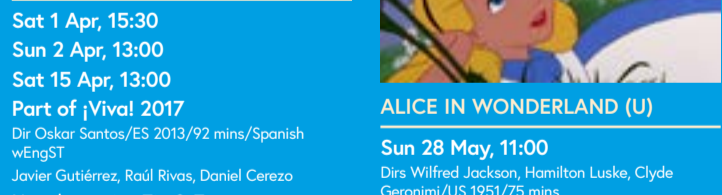
