What are the costs?

A range of training packages are available. Read on to find out more and select the best option for you and your team.

Where does the training take place?

Wherever you are! We've developed a fully accredited remote training package delivered online by our Carbon Literacy Trainers. All you need is an internet connection and a laptop, tablet or mobile with Zoom installed. We offer specific dates and times for training, or you can contact us to discuss bespoke training packages.

What does training entail?

Over the course of 4 remotely delivered modules you'll receive a full day's worth of training. You'll become **aware** of climate crisis and its causes, you'll gain the **knowledge** and **skills** to reduce your carbon impact and understand the **value** of your actions.

You'll receive certification from the Carbon Literacy Project. Included in the cost of training, you'll become a member of HOME's Creative Climate Action Community to continue to build on your learning. Over the course of 12 months, you'll receive e-newsletters and the opportunity to join two additional carbon awareness sessions.

Training Outline:

1. Film (1 hour)
2. Webinar (1 hour)
3. Workshop Part 1 (1.5 hours)
4. Workshop Part 2 (1.5 hours)

There will be independent learning tasks between modules. At the end of the training you will complete a participant action form that is submitted to the Carbon Literacy Project for certification.

What are the benefits?

Who is the trainer?

Training Packages

We offer two types of training package:

- 1) Full day training with HOME (includes individuals)
- 2) Full day training for your organisation

All training packages include cost of certification and 12-month membership to HOME's Creative Climate Action Community.
