How old do I need to be to volunteer?

When are volunteer shifts likely to take place?

We are currently recruiting volunteers to support our HOME Launch Weekend which takes place from Thursday 21 May to Monday 25 May. There will be a range of shifts throughout the day from mornings through to evenings and lates. All volunteers will need to attend a training session on either Wednesday 13 May (17:00-20:00) or Friday 15 May (13:00-16:00).

Can I continue to volunteer after the opening weekend?

Yes! Although this recruitment is for a short term opportunity, we will be developing our volunteer programme as we settle into our new venue. As more opportunities become available we'll make sure you're the first to know about them.

What training will I receive?

Our training session will cover: everything you need to know about HOME and our opening programme, an induction to the new HOME building, an introduction to the HOME opening team, health and safety training, and an opportunity to socialise with other volunteers.

Will you reimburse my expenses?

Yes - we can reimburse travel expenses (up to a limit of £7) every time you volunteer. We will also reimburse you for meals (up to £5) if you're volunteering for more than 4 hours at a time.

Are there any benefits for volunteers?

As a volunteer you will be entitled to complimentary theatre/cinema tickets, as well as a discount in the HOME Café. We'll confirm exactly what benefits are available during the induction process.
