The Home We Made is a brand-new piece of theatre that throws open Manchester's front door and invites you in. Created with Home from HOME community groups and local artists, it's a celebration of belonging, of the bonds that grow between neighbours, friends, and strangers who choose to stand side by side.

Brick by brick, laugh by laugh, memory by memory, it fills with everything that makes this city legendary; warmth, grit, humour, heart. While Manchester grows taller, its roots run deeper. Come and see what happens when a city builds a home together.
